## What do they need?

- Food items: Spaghetti sauce, noodles, ramen noodles, canned soup, granola/cereal bars, boxed cereal, instant oatmeal, canned fruit, canned vegetables, peanut butter, jelly, canned tuna, canned chicken, helper/skillet meals, rice, dried or canned beans, flour, sugar
- Personal hygiene items: hand and bar soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, body soap, shampoo, conditioner, facial tissues, toilet paper, diapers
- In addition to collecting food and personal hygiene products we will be collecting plastic and/or paper bags. **Bags will NOT be counted towards class totals.**
